#### **Adventure Sports**

But one has to be mentally very tough and physically fit to undertake this sport. Cycling or biking has its own advantages too. It is said that if one wants to learn about the local culture of a place, there is no better way than to cycle through it. One can stop at the towns and villages whenever one wishes to and experience the way of life there. There are several tiny villages on the foothills of the Himalayas with unique customs, traditions and folklore which are an interesting experience.

Some of the best places for mountain biking are in the Himalayan regions of Jammu and Kashmir, Uttar Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Sikkim and Arunachal Pradesh.

Mountain biking requires the use of special bikes. The cycles are specially fitted with multi-speed gears so that the cyclist does not require much effort to cycle uphill. The thrill and adventure of course is when the cyclist travels downhill!




